Nomination via e-mail	Partner institutions must communicate their nominated students (name, email address, periode of stay, current degree of study) by e-mail to: murielle.ravelojaona@versailles.archi.fr An application process will be sent to the student(s) in return.
Deadline	Fall semester / a year : June 9 th , 2017 Spring semester : November 10 th , 2017
Portfolio	Students must bring with them a portfolio (A4) in September with samples of their work.
Extra-fee	Liability Insurance: about 25/30€
For students outside UE	Sécurité sociale (French national healthcare) is mandatory : 217€/year
